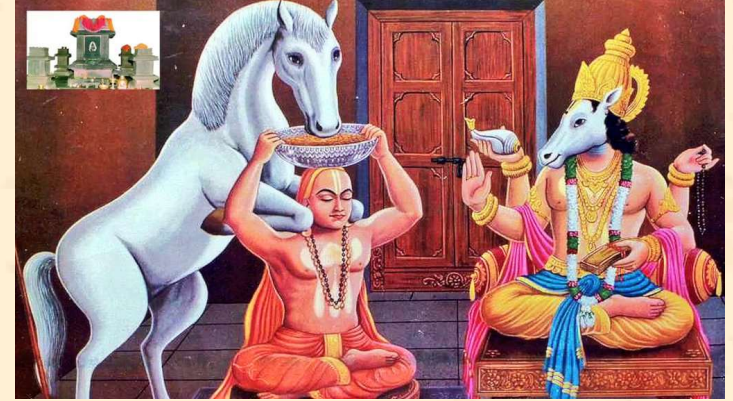

- Ashrama Name: Vishnu Tirtha
- Sanyasa Ashrama: 1525

- Author of 104 granthas!
- Sri Vijayeendrateertha defeats the Prostitutes
- Shaiva Kshetra or Vaishnavakshetra

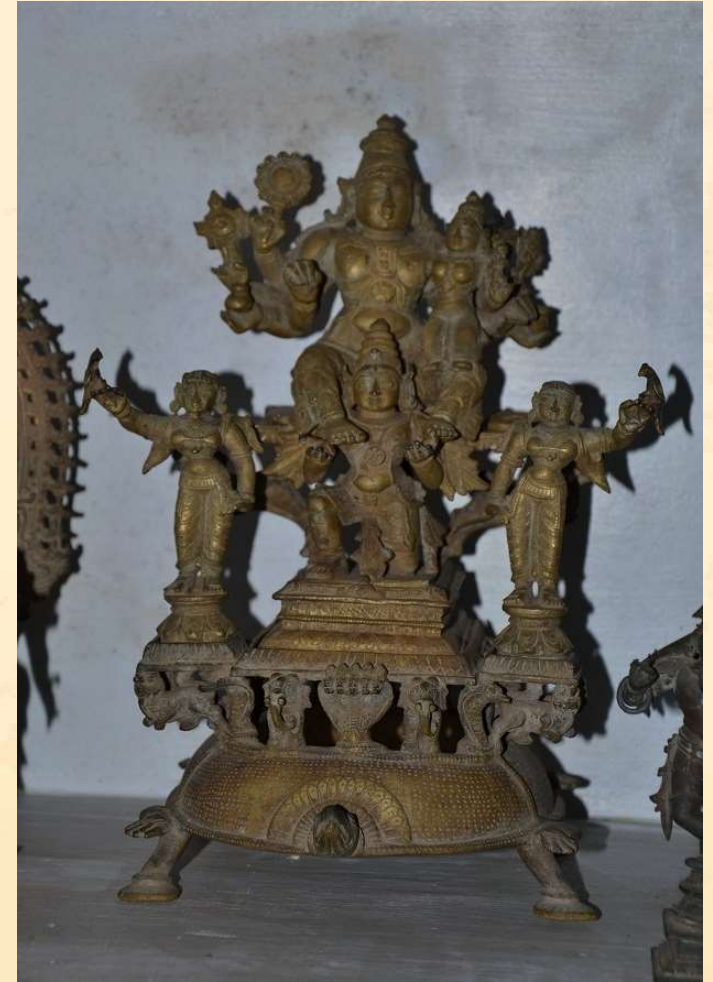

Sri Raghottama Teertha

- 1556-1596
- Guru: Sri Raghuvariateertha
- Faces humiliation at the scholar's house
- Learnt the Vedantic text in his dreams
- Adya Varadacharya apologizes
- Rotti Venkatadri Bhatta: Cook to world renowned scholar
- Yadavarya, the jeweler turns Scholar par excellence
- Mutt employs own staff



Sri Raghottamateertha Vrindavana

Sri Raghavendraswami

- 1623-1671
- Focus on shastra studies, 'Mahabhashya' title
- The 'debate': Sri Yadavendrateertha & Sri Raghavendrateertha
- Sri Raghavendraswami and Sri Bidarahalli Srinivasa 'teertha'
- Sajeeva Vrindavana pravesha
- Master of Simplification and Elaboration

Sri Raghottama Teertha	1556-1596	Bhaava Bodha Kararu
Sri Raghavendra Swami	1623-1671	Parimalacharya and Tippanyacharya

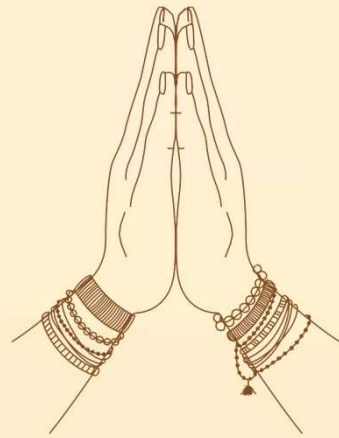
